Fire Chief Delegation

Fire Chief Doug Holt visited Council to discuss Alberta Health Services plans to consolidate dispatch centres throughout the province. The Fire Chief is concerned that consolidation will result in communication inefficiencies and negatively affect emergency response.

Council passed 1st Readings of a Rescinding Bylaw, and amended Animal Regulations and Solid Waste Management Bylaws. Administration will share more information with the public on these bylaws in the coming days.
